Dear Applicant:

Under the “ Enforcement Officers Safety Act” qualified active and retired law enforcement officers are permitted to carry concealed handguns nationwide. The law amends the Gun Control Act (18 U.S.C. Chapter 44) to exempt qualified active and retired law enforcement officers from state and local laws prohibiting the carry of concealed firearms.

In accordance with the Federal Act, Illinois passed Public Act 94-103 (2005) that provides for the annual certification of retired law enforcement officers qualified under federal law to carry a concealed weapon.

Enclosed please find an application packet containing forms that must be completed, signed and returned. The application must be accompanied by the required documents as listed on the application form.

Please read all materials carefully prior to completing the application. All required supporting documentation and the application fee must accompany the application or the application will not be processed and will be returned.

Once the application has been pre-approved, you will receive notification and at that time be allowed to enroll in the certification shoot at one of the statewide range sites. Upon successful completion of the certification shoot, a card signifying your successful completion of the State requirements will be mailed to you.
