You will be provided two opportunities to certify at the range – shooting a total of 30 rounds for each opportunity. If you are qualifying with two weapons, a revolver and a semi-automatic, you will be given one opportunity (30 rounds) for each weapon.

Distances fired from Target: 5, 7, and 15 yards

Target Scoring Area: In order to qualify, you must place 21 hits out of 30 rounds within the 8 ½ x 14 inch target area (overlay/center mass of target) for a 70% proficiency.

Handgun Type: Semi-auto/Revolver; minimum capacity 5 rounds

For retired officer qualification, all stages of fire will commence with the handgun in hand from the “low ready” position.

The word “PRESENT” means that the shooter has the handgun in the shooting hand in low ready (depressed muzzle) position and stands ready for the command to fire.
